Save More on Transit

Skip high prices at the pumps and ride bus or rail instead. You'll save even more with these transit deals:

In **Los Angeles County**, low-income riders may qualify for a free monthly pass and/or half-price weekly and monthly passes through July 20 with the LIFE program.

It's only **\$10 to ride Metrolink** all day on Saturday or Sunday. Now, kids ride free on weekends (up to three per paying adult). Another deal: **Metrolink's 5-Day Flex Pass** saves riders 10% over regular round-trip ticket prices.

OC Bus Value Pass, available through July 15, offers savings of up to 40% over regular fares.

Omnitrans is offering a free upgrade on its app, giving riders greater flexibility in managing their bus rides.

Fares on **VCTC and Valley Express buses** are half price through June.
